

All parking spaces on North Little Rock Public Library System property are reserved for library visitors and individuals conducting library business. The Library reserves the right to remove any motor vehicle, trailer, bicycle, or other non-motorized vehicle from its property when parked in violation of this policy. Examples include, but are not limited to:

- Parking a vehicle for any purpose unrelated to the use of the Library
- Apparent abandonment of a vehicle
- Failure to display a valid license plate
- Parking that creates a hazard to vehicular or pedestrian traffic
- Parking that obstructs emergency equipment or access routes

This list is illustrative, not exhaustive. The Library may remove vehicles for other significant reasons consistent with the safe and intended use of Library property. The registrant of any towed vehicle is responsible for all towing and related costs. The Library assumes no responsibility for damage to a vehicle or its contents when removal occurs under this policy.

- A. Vehicles may only be parked in designated parking areas clearly marked with traffic control devices.
- B. No vehicle may be parked in a manner that obstructs vehicular or pedestrian traffic.
- C. No person may park a vehicle in a way that causes damage to Library property.
- D. Vehicles must be parked entirely within the boundaries of a marked parking stall. Parking on or over the lines of an adjacent space is prohibited.
- E. Parking spaces reserved for individuals with disabilities are clearly marked and restricted at all times. Only vehicles displaying an official disabled license plate or windshield tag may park in these spaces. Unofficial permits or decals are not valid. Police will be notified of violations, which carry a fine of \$100.00 for each offense.
- F. Motorcycles and mopeds may not be parked on sidewalks, landscaped areas, or other non-designated locations. They must be parked in designated motor-vehicle stalls.
- G. Motor vehicles are not permitted to drive on sidewalks at any time.
